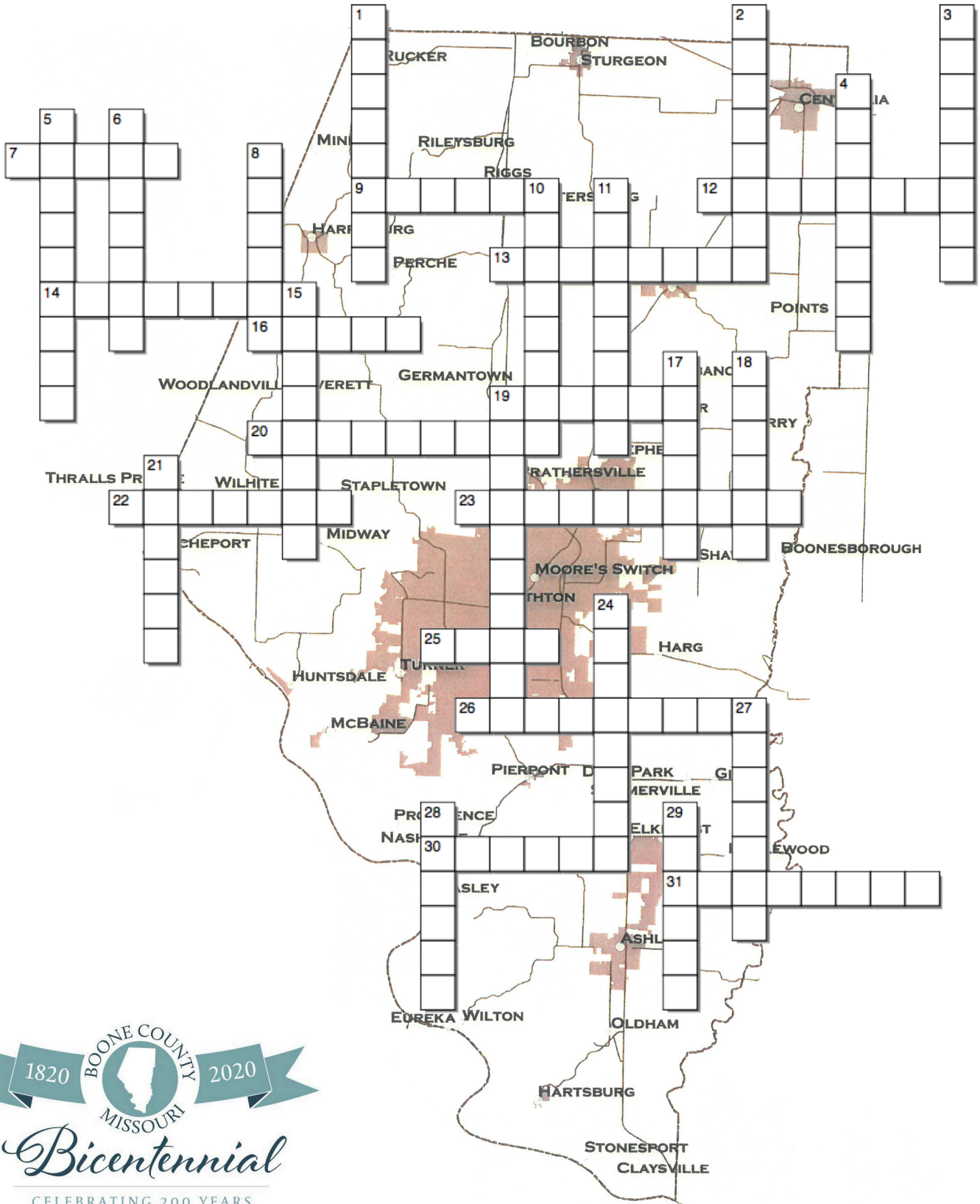


Boone County Crossword Puzzle
